Call to Worship and Lent Cross "Questions Jesus Asked" from Matt. 20

- One: Jesus asked questions; questions that made people think, questions that invited His followers into a deeper relationship and commitment to Him.
- ALL: Two blind men were sitting by the roadside. When they heard that Jesus was going by, they shouted, "Lord, have mercy on us!"
- One: Jesus stopped and called them. "What do you want Me to do for you?" He asked.
- ALL: "Lord," they answered, "we want our sight."
- One: Jesus had compassion on them and touched their eyes. Immediately they received their sight and followed Him.
- ALL: Lord, You ask questions of us, too.
