


AN EXTRA PLACE AT THE TABLE

Our church is a partner with International Justice Mission. IJM works all over the world to help free people from slavery, particularly women and children, and young children who are victims of sex trafficking and exploitation. In December we asked if we might help their program to **defend**

widows and orphans who often lose everything to debt, through property grabbing and the greed of others who prey on the vulnerable. \$60 can help one such family be rescued from violence, win back what was stolen, and make sure they are safe enough to thrive again. IJM will help each widow get back on her feet to provide for her family and make sure orphans are cared for and that their rights are protected as they grow up.

Through your amazing, Spirit-inspired generosity, we exceeded the goal of helping 3 widows and their children –
