



Until 1878, a pew rental was charged. Until the envelope offering system was adopted on May 31 (moved by Mr. Robert Rae and Mr. James Gordon) pew rental amounts were baed on how many sat in the

pew. 5 people - \$9.00 per year; 4, \$8, 3, \$5 and a single, \$3. The "shields" on the centre aisle pew side once held gold painted numbers, as families reserved a particular pew.
