

- One: Jesus asked questions; questions that made people think, questions that invited His followers into a deeper relationship and commitment to Him.
- ALL: After the Palm Sunday parade, Jesus told His followers again that He would face suffering and death.
- One: Jesus said, "Now I am very troubled. What should I say? Should I say, 'Father save me from this time of suffering'? No, I came to this time so that I could suffer. Father, do what will bring You glory!"


