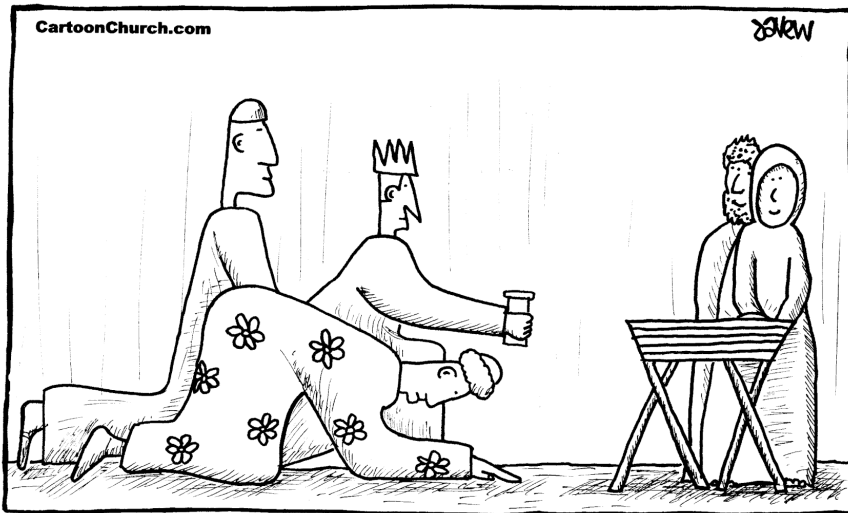

Second Sunday In Advent

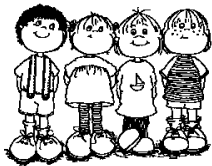
It's ADVENT...so we're in a new time zone: the beginning of the Christian year. The Christian year keeps us focused on God's time and presence and purpose...and begins with Advent, the weeks of waiting, watching, preparing and praying to welcome Jesus Christ anew in our hearts, homes and world. During Advent we "mark time" with candles, lighting one candle each week as a sign of the growing light that draws us to Jesus, the Light of the World. You may wish to adapt this practice at home as well!

Our worship series this year is **CHRISTMAS AT THE MOVIES**. Each week we'll look at one of the classic Christmas movies, and how that movie and the message of the Bible speak to us in this season. This week: **A CHRISTMAS CAROL**. We all know the story and the name of Ebenezer Scrooge. His name is synonymous with many things – none of them good. But there's more to the story than his name. And more to our story than the name we carry, too.
