We stand at a key time, but not a discouraging time. Society is more secular and the contrast with Christians will be ever more clear. As such, the big question is: "Will that contrast be between a secular world and Christians that listen and love like Jesus, leading people to Him, or will we be something else?"






HEY PASTOR, LAST WEEK'S 'MORE LIKE JESUS' SERMON REALLY INSPIRED ME


