The Ladies Aid Society was formed in the later 1800's. The first recorded account is dated March 30, 1893, with Mrs. Currie (no doubt Rev. Hector's wife) was

president, with Mrs. Telfer as Vice President. Over the years the Ladies Aid Society supported the church with teas, strawberry socials, bazaars and more. A strawberry social held here in 1905 charged 15 cents admission, and 5 cents for ice cream with the strawberries. The Forest Excelsior Band provided entertainment, charging the Ladies Aid Society \$10 for their services that day.
