Owen: Why do we give thanks and praise as we come to God's table?

Pastor: We say thank You to God, who has created the world and all of us, who has shown us His love in our Risen Saviour, Jesus Christ, and who lives in us through the Holy Spirit. **ALL: we thank you, Lord God!**

Carson: Why do we eat bread at this table?
Pastor: Jesus Christ used bread to show His disciples, and all who come to the Lord's Table, that He gave His body to be broken on the cross to show us His love.

ALL: We eat the bread with thankful hearts for God's love!

Owen: Why do we drink from little cups at this table?

Pastor: Jesus Christ took a cup of wine, and used it to show His disciples, and all who come to the Lord's Table, that He shed His blood on the cross to forgive us for all the wrong things we think, say and do, and all the right things we don't think, say and do. Jesus said that the cup was a very special promise of love between God and His people.

ALL: We drink from the cup with thankful hearts for God's forgiveness.

Carson: What do we remember at this table?
ALL: We remember God's gracious love for us, Christ's death and resurrection for us, and the Spirit's powerful presence and tender care for us. We remember that in Jesus Christ, we live new lives and have new beginnings!

⊕ We Pray With Thankful Hearts

One: The Lord be with you!

All: And also with you! One: Lift up your hearts!

All: We lift them up to the Lord!

One: Let us give thanks to God! All: We praise You, Lord! One: O Lord, how thankful we are for all You have done, and all You are doing still! With Your people everywhere, we praise You!

All: Send Your Holy Spirit upon us, and these gifts of bread and the cup, that we may be one with Christ, and Christ abide in us forever.
