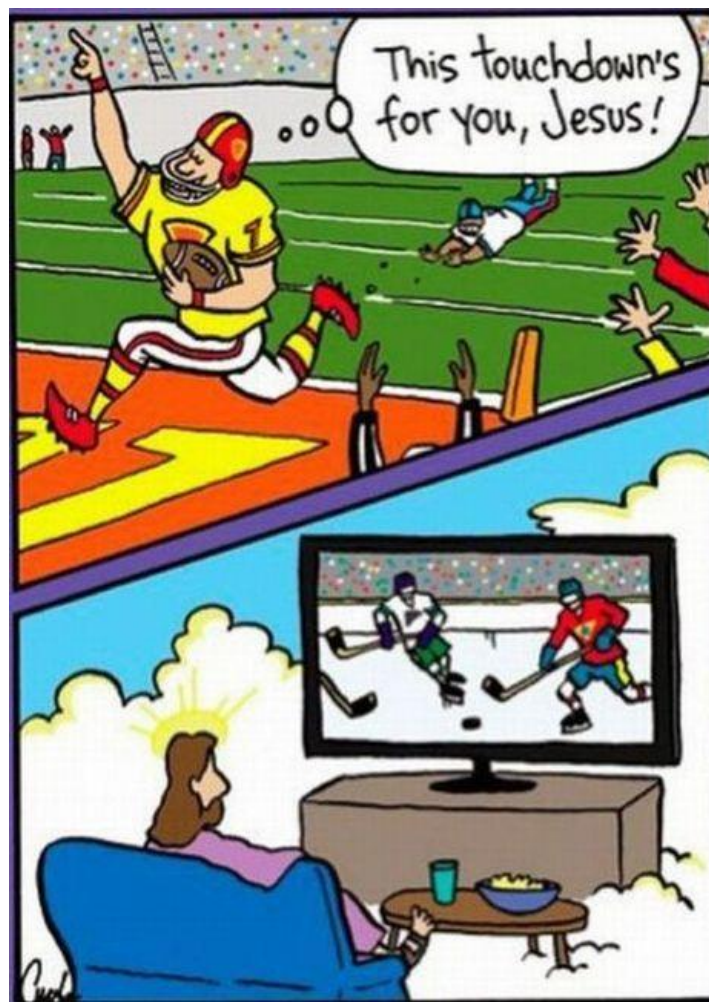

A look ahead...

Lent begins February 26. We will have a short Ash Wednesday service that day; time to be announced.

During Lent, our focus will be the Sermon on the Mount, as we begin exploring “THE WAY IS JESUS”, working our way through much of the Gospel of Matthew.

In August, we will shift to “FOLLOWERS OF THE WAY”, with a series in the Book of Acts.

In September, “ANXIOUS FOR NOTHING” is our theme, trusting God to make a way for us to know hope and peace in the midst of our stress, worry and anxiety.

We will have a “VIEW FROM THE PEW” series before Advent 2020 begins.
