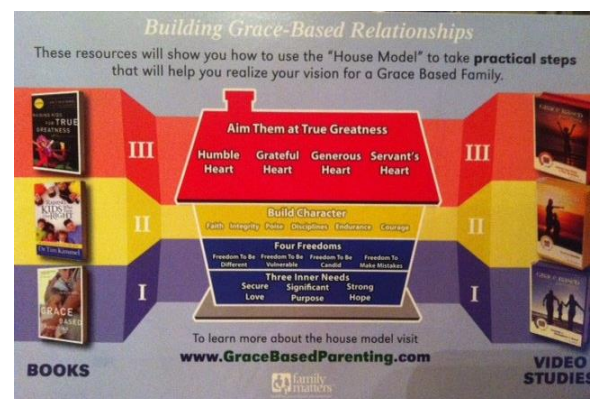

HOLY WEEK AND EASTER services STARTS MARCH 28



While we can't gather in person, we can and will worship the Lord during this most important week of the year for Christians. Here's an outline of what you'll need and what opportunities are available for you with your KPC family this year!

Palm Sunday We can't be together again this year, so I would ask that you prepare for Palm Sunday at home! You can make your own palm leaves...perhaps a local florist will let you purchase enough for your household. We will do as we did last year – find some cedar or evergreen branches around your house...have them for the service on Sunday, and then hang them outdoors – on your door, porch, mailbox at the end of the laneway!

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday We will have short 20 minutes of prayer, a scripture reading and a song livestreamed from the church, starting at 7.00 p.m. This year, we will read some of the teachings and parables of Jesus during the first "Holy Week".

MAUNDY THURSDAY Join us at 7 p.m. for worship. We will celebrate the Lord's Supper, as Jesus and His first followers did. Please have 2 candles ready; please have bread (for this night, pita bread, naan bread, flatbread, or plain crackers would be wonderful!) and juice or wine prepared for each member of your household.

GOOD FRIDAY At 7 p.m. we will worship and gather at the cross. Jesse and I are preparing nail cross kits for you, and your household. Children will need some assistance. **We will have those available starting this weekend for pick up.** As part of the service you will be making a cross of nails. You will also need a candle.

HOLY SATURDAY I invite you to spend one hour on Saturday with no internet, phone, TV radio on. Experience the silence. You might spend that hour reading the Bible. Praying. Walking in silence, even at a cemetery, and thinking about life and death, and how we live our lives with Jesus.

We will be gathering as Kid Connection to make resurrection cookies, starting at 6.30 p.m.

EASTER 9.30 a.m. for worship as we celebrate! Again, please have bread (*wonderful, flavourful, your favourite bread!*) and wine or juice for communion; please have a brand new candle ready to light. If you wish, you may also get a small bouquet of fresh flowers to bring out and place where you sit for worship.
