

USE WORDS Colossians 4:5-6

TO CONTINUE THE CONVERSATION

1. Who spoke of Jesus to you? whose words and life drew you to faith? Reflect on that relationship. Give thanks.
2. Think of people you know, and may even love, who are not believers. Yet. Commit to praying – yes for them, but also for you – to live wisely, make the most of every opportunity, to be gracious and thoughtful in your words...and for the Holy Spirit to guide you and them.
3. Begin to craft a one to two minute “waiting in line” story of your own faith. *Who Jesus is to you? Why does He matter? How has faith helped you?* Write it down. Speak it out loud to yourself. Re-read Colossians 4:5-6...does your “waiting-in-line” story reflect this teaching? Be ready for some opportunity, God-given, when it comes to use your words.
